

REVELATION AND RELATED SCRIPTURE

Summary of the Series.

All audio/visuals run automatically with the slides synchronised to the speech.

Most browsers allow the sequence to be varied forward or backward as desired by using the various controls underneath or on the right side of the slide.

If a presentation is selected after previously viewing only some of it, a panel will allow resuming the presentation from the last slide viewed previously, or restarting from the beginning.

Understanding Prophecy – This presentation deals with some basic matters relating to a proper understanding of Bible prophecy. It emphasises the long-established principle that states “When the plain sense of Scripture makes sense, seek no other sense.” (35 minutes)

God’s Plan for the Future – An overview of end-time prophecy from the present time to the new heavens and new earth in eternity. (35 minutes)

Revelation Outline and Introduction – The big picture of the book of Revelation summarising each of the main sections of the book. It also includes an introduction to chapter 1 of the book. (39 minutes)

Letters to 7 Churches – This illustrates the structure of the letters, using illustrations from several of them. It describes the 4 ways that these letters have application, including the way they illustrate the history of the church down through the ages. (33 minutes)

The Church in Heaven – Chapters 4 and 5 of Revelation deal with the church worshipping at the throne in heaven following the rapture. It answers a number of questions about the time when Christians stand before the judgment seat of Christ. (31 minutes)

Revelation and the Olivet Discourse – Matthew, Mark and Luke all record many of Jesus’ words when His disciples asked Him about the times of the end. This presentation compares the gospel records with the prophecies of Revelation. (30 minutes)

Judgments and Witnesses – The ‘Trumpet’ judgments are dealt with in this presentation which covers Revelation 8 to 11. The described effects of those judgments are compared to certain events described by secular scientists; there is considerable correlation. It also covers the events relating to God’s two witnesses. (39 minutes)

The 70 Weeks of Daniel – This short prophecy in Daniel chapter 9 provides details in addition to those in Revelation, particularly about the Antichrist, his origin, and his actions. Whilst the first part of the prophecy has already been fulfilled, it is included to illustrate the incredible accuracy with which God’s Word is fulfilled. (29 minutes)

The World Under Antichrist – Revelation 12 and 13 provide much detail about the Antichrist and the False Prophet and the image that demands worship. Those chapters describe the power and authority they will exercise over the whole world and give some insight into that terrible time of judgment. (38 minutes)

Image of the Beast – The False Prophet commands the world to make an image of the beast (Antichrist) that commands the world to worship him or be killed. This presentation examines the

various technologies that could be used to produce the image. The conclusion that is reached is rather surprising. (36 minutes)

Visions of the End 1 – Much was revealed to the prophet Daniel about the time of the end. Daniel chapter 11 describes the Antichrist and his actions providing additional insight into this evil person. (40 minutes)

Visions of the End 2 – Daniel 12 supplements the description in Revelation of the events at the time of the end. It gives some details about the timing of those events and the world conditions that will exist at that time. (38 minutes)

God's Final Wrath – The subject is the events described in Revelation chapters 14 to 18. These include the 'Vial' judgments, the expression of God's final wrath being poured out on an evil world and its leader, Antichrist. Also included is a discussion on the judgment of the 'woman', the apostate church of the last days. (38 minutes)

Sheep and Goats Judgment – This event is not directly described in Revelation, but Jesus spoke clearly about it as recorded in Matthew chapter 25. It is the time at the end of the Tribulation where those who survive the terrible judgments are judged and a decision made about their entry into the Millennial Kingdom or 'away into everlasting punishment' is made. (22 minutes)

Millennial Kingdom – After a short interval of 75 days the Millennial Kingdom will begin and last for 1000 years. This presentation asks and answers many questions about this period in which Christ will rule as King of Kings and Lord of Lords from Jerusalem. It also deals with the judgment at the Great White Throne. (39 minutes)

The Lord's Final Words – Revelation chapters 21 and 22 contain much good news. They describe the New Heavens and New Earth and the majesty and glory of the King of Kings. His words to us in chapter 22 are His final words before the rapture. They are especially described because they have great significance and relevance to us in these last days. (23 minutes)
